We would like to remind you that the Novel H1N1 Flu (Swine Flu) continues to be present in the City of Wausau and Marathon County.

The Wausau School District custodial staff continues to be vigilant with a cleaning protocol that focuses on touchable objects and the use of residual disinfectants.

The incubation period for the H1N1 Flu (Swine Flu) is 1 to 7 days. Influenza is spread primarily from person-to-person through coughing or sneezing. The symptoms of H1N1 Flu (Swine Flu) are similar to the regular seasonal influenza and include fever (greater than 100° F), cough, sore throat, head/body ache, and lethargy. If your child has any of these symptoms **keep your child at home** and call your personal physician. The best way to prevent influenza is to wash your hands often, cover your cough, eat well, get enough sleep, and reduce your stress.
